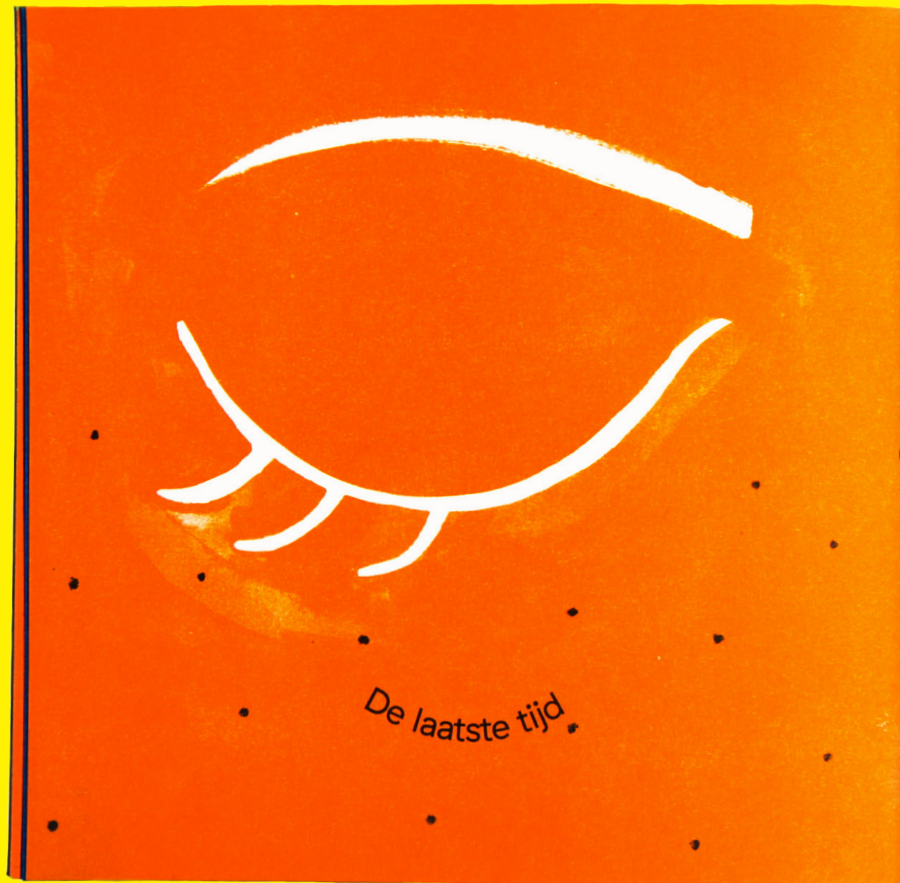


Birthe Janssens (1998)
